The Tournament saw 128 players competing. Five players including Swetha Steffi (from Chennai) represented the state, out of which one player was from Erode and the other from Madurai.

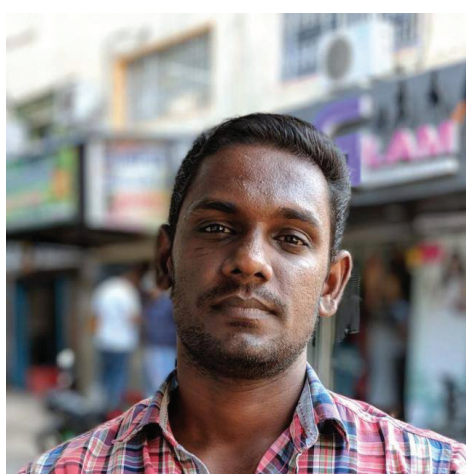

He joined YRG CARE in 2015 to work with adolescents and children in schools and colleges to provide them with life skills education. He worked for Endrum Punna-gai (ever smiling)—a project of YRG CARE that aims to provide life skills education for disadvantaged boys and girls studying in government schools in Chennai. He has an experience of more than 4 years in training teachers, women, youth, and adolescents. His last innovative work was an interactive psychosocial program called Camp Rainbow for children living with HIV. He worked as a project associate for the India Partnership Initiative (IPI) supported by the Serious Fun Children's Network to provide camp experiences for children living with HIV and other serious illnesses. He served as a logistics coordinator for Camp Rainbow Chennai from 2016 to 2019 and group leader coordinator for Camp Rainbow Batlagundu from 2017 to 2018.

We are continuously monitoring the progress of other candidates by being in regular touch with them as well as their coaches. Some new applications have also been received, and our selection panelists are in the process of considering them on a merit basis for adoption by the Energy Projekt.
