**Mr. Ilamparthi** received an individual performance gold medal, and the Indian team won the gold medal in the World School Teams Tournament at Alexandria, Washington, DC, USA.

He clinches bronze medal at FIDE World Youth Under-16 Chess Olympiad 2025 in Barranquilla, Colombia.



Now he is in training camp. After that, he will participate in the Sweden tournament from 22nd to 26th September.





Women Candidate Master (WCM) **A. S. Sharvaanica** finishes third place in the Girls Under-10 category in the World Cup and qualifies for the Cadet Championship to represent our country in the FIDE World Cup to be held in Batumi, Georgia.



The competition went down to the wire in the seventh round, with just one point separating Tamil Nadu's Sharvaanica and WCM Divi Bijesh. Their final-round match ended in a draw, placing Sharvaanica behind Divi in the Group B standings. She then faced the runner-up from Group A, Volkova Nadezhda, in a play-off match and defeated her to clinch third place. Her only loss came in the second round against fellow Indian Vanshika Rawat. During the group stage, she registered wins against opponents, including Kazakhstan's Zhetpis Symbat and India's Kiyana Parihar. With this podium finish, Sharvaanica has qualified to represent India at the FIDE World Cadet Championships, scheduled to be held in September this year.

Sharvaanica (Under-10) achieved three prize spots—team gold, board gold, and individual silver—in the Under-17 Girls category CBSE National School Chess Championship held in Udaipur, Rajasthan. Also, Sharvaanica is going to represent India in the FIDE World Cadet Championships at Almaty, Kazakhstan, from 18 September to 3 October.

**Mr. R. Nijesh** (School Chess Team) won the championship title, first prize in the Under-14 category in the National Chess Championship for CBSE Schools, held in Udaipur, Rajasthan.

Teams were selected from nine zones across India, and teams from foreign countries such as Qatar, Oman, and Kuwait affiliated with CBSE schools also participated. In this tournament, students Nijesh, Kavin, Kishore Parjith, and Parthinarayan, who were selected after winning the Southern Zone-1, won all the competitions and were crowned champions.



**Nijesh's** achievement crossed 1992 from 1815 in classical this year.

Nijesh won 1st place (Blitz) and 15th place out of 400 players (Classical Open Category); and he received ₹10,000 (Classical) + ₹3000 (Blitz) cash prize and score: 7/9 (both) in SRR International Open & Blitz FIDE rating tournament at Vijayawada.

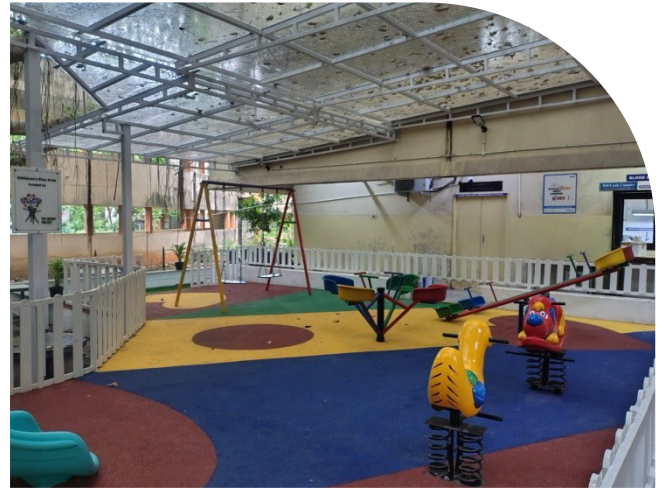


## CHILDREN'S PLAY AREA (RECREATIONAL CENTER)
