### Master Sharvaanica AS

has made the country proud by winning gold and being crowned the new world champion in the Under-10 Girls category at the FIDE World Cadet Championship, which concluded in Kazakhstan.

It was a slow start for the World Rapid champion, who lost the opening round but came back strongly with nine consecutive victories to finish with 9 out of 11 points and secure the top prize.

Sharvaanica was the only Indian player to be crowned champion from a national contingent of nearly 30 participants in a tournament that saw players from over 90 countries.

In the final round, she faced a tough defeat against Zhou Abigail from the United States. Meanwhile, Nandinjiguur Chinzorig from Mongolia drew her game on board 2, also finishing with 9 points. However, as the first tie-break criterion was the result of the direct encounter—Sharvaanica had defeated Nandinjiguur earlier in the tournament—she was declared the champion.

## Master Savitha Shri

delivered a standout performance at the World Rapid Chess Championships, finishing an impressive fourth overall and playing a decisive role in the title race.

In the final round, Savitha held Koneru Humpy to a gritty draw, denying the Indian veteran the chance to win the championship outright. The result meant that Humpy—due to a lower tie-break score—eventually finished third. Savitha’s composure under pressure drew widespread praise from the chess community.

This is not Savitha’s first big moment on the world stage. She had earlier won the bronze medal at the 2022 World Rapid Championships, and her latest showing further underlines her steady rise as one of the India’s brightest young chess talents.

Savitha Shri also performed in the 6<sup>th</sup> Ellopagate Open Chess Tournament, finishing third overall and emerging as the best women player.

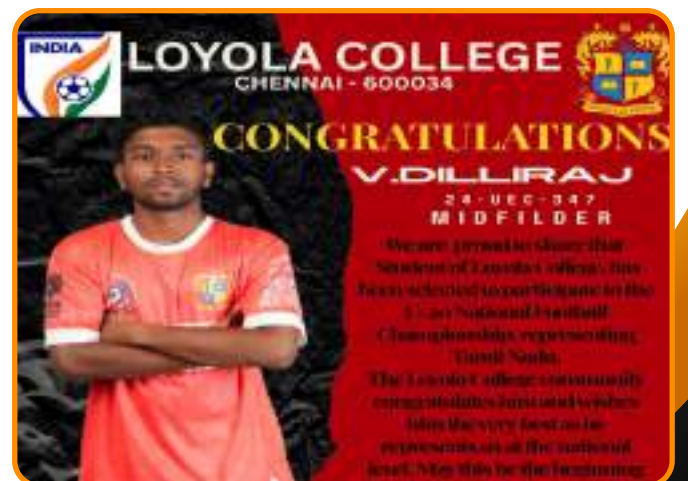
